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3. COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Being a sand based product, there is a risk that the Respirable Crystalline Silica (RCS) content may be hazardous to human health. While the product is wet and being applied as per the directions on the package, the amount of airborne Respirable Crystalline Silica (RCS) will be minimal and over exposure via inhalation is not anticipated but it is still recommended that proper PPE is worn. Once dry any residues, grinding or strong abrasive forces etc may reintroduce RCS into the air so precautions should be taken

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

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. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Storage Store off the floor in the original bags in a cool, dry, well ventilated area, removed from

excessive moisture and heat. Ensure packages are adequately labelled, protected from

physical damage and sealed when not in use.

Handling Dried Sand is supplied in 20 bags. Recognised local safe lifting methods should be used.

Before use carefully read the product label. Use of safe work practices are recommended to avoid eye or skin contact and inhalation. Observe good personal hygiene, including washing hands before eating. Prohibit eating, drinking, and smoking in contaminated

areas.

Ventilation Do not inhale dust/powder. Use with adequate ventilation. Where a dust inhalation

hazard exists, mechanical extraction ventilation is recommended. Maintain dust levels

below the recommended exposure standard.
